Objectives and Activities

Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

To advance the education of the pupils in the School and in furtherance of this object the Association may:

- Develop more extended relationships between staff, parents/guardians and others associated with the School:
- · Engage in activities which support the School and advance the education of pupils attending it;
- Provide and assist in the provision of facilities for education at the School (not normally provided by the Department of Education).

Summary of the main activities undertaken for public benefit in relation to these objects

- Raising funds to supplement and support the school's educational activities, through such events as Summer and Christmas fairs, sales of preloved school uniforms and the 200 Club monthly draw.
- Providing logistical support for school activities and events and generally providing a link between the students' parents/carers and the teaching/governing body.

Achievements and Performance

The Nonsuch High School PTA normally runs a series of events throughout the year to engage and support parents-and-raise funds-for the school. After a-sombre and-quiet year, the new PTA committee began meeting virtually from January 2021. We quickly gathered pace and initiated an online Easter Raffle, in April and we raised nearly £3000. This boosted our energy levels, and as the schools-gradually reopened, the PTA enjoyed-organising the leavers! breakfast and the Preloved-Uniform sales. In the new academic year, we have planned a few fundraising events, including a virtual balloon race (attracting new sponsorship income), the PTA Quiz Night, and the Christmas Fair, to-continue supporting our childrens! education and wellbeing. We welcomed the New Year 7 parents, virtually, and are looking at organising a Welcome event in a few weeks.

For the financial year 2020/21, the PTA ended the year with a net surplus of just under £7,800 on its Income and Expenditure account. Some of our significant contributions for the academic year 2020/2021 are highlighted below:

200 Club Draws

The '200 Club' is a cornerstone activity in raising funds and this year, despite challenging circumstances, we raised a net amount in excess of £4300.

The Easter Raffle

The PTA Committee had a successful raffle using the website www.raffall.com before Easter, and raised close to £2900.

Preloved Uniform Sale

The PTA Committee organised a Preloved Uniform Sale on 10th July 2021 at the Nonsuch High School hall, Ewell Road, Cheam, Surrey. SM3 8AB and total generated sales of uniforms for the year of over £1900.

Contributions to the School

This year the PTA was able to aid a number of school funding requests that contributed towards supporting learning and for the well-being of the students. This included:

1. SUPPORTING NOTES

- a. Cash in Hand of £107 includes £80 (two floats of £40 each with Chandra Hughes) and c£27.12 (cash handed over by Vidyha Murali to Ipshita Chatterjee)
- b. 14 Unpresented Cheques as at 31st August 2021 relate to 200 Club prizes amounting to £1165, which have been accrued for
- c. Expenditure accrued for in 2020 relating to unclaimed 200 Club prizes (£795) going back more than 4 years, in the form of Unpresented Cheques, were reversed back into the accounts in 2021 and added to the surplus
- d. Income in Advance of £124 from 21 parents for attendance at the Year 7 Welcome Event in September 2021 and £250 in sponsorship for a Balloon Race, has been accounted for in the Balance Sheet
- e. An amount of £62 accrued for in 2020 relating to refunds owed for a cancelled Parents Quiz Night were returned to the accounts in 2021 and added back to the surplus
