



PTA Going Cashless

In the last couple of years the PTA has rolled out alternative payment methods for the various services and products offered. We have now taken the decision that all payments to the PTA must be cashless. The only exception will be certain events such as doughnut day where buyers (i.e. pupils) may not have contactless cards to pay. There are 3 key drivers for going cashless. Firstly, as a charity we need to have good governance in place so keeping a record of cash coming in and what it is for is absolutely key. Secondly, we have a limited number of volunteers to cover all roles so we have to look for areas of efficiency. Going cashless means our treasurer does not have to worry about keeping a cash float at the right level. So if you are attending a school event where refreshments are being sold by the PTA please remember to bring your Card for payments. The other main advantage of going cashless and using electronic payments is that it allows the PTA to see what products sell well and helps us manage stock levels more efficiently.



PTA Agrees initial £15,000 of funding for 2022-2023
