


£15,000 of funding committed to School

We are delighted to share some exciting news with you regarding the recent initiatives funded by the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA). Thanks to your overwhelming generosity, the PTA was able to commit £15,000 towards enriching the experiences of our students at Nonsuch High School for Girls. In the face of the current cost of living crisis, your support has been truly remarkable, and we are immensely grateful for the community's dedication to our school's well-being. The funds raised will contribute significantly to enhancing the educational journey of our children. Here is a glimpse of some of the items and initiatives that your contributions will be supporting:



Left: Ice Cream Makers - £240 has been donated by the PTA to cover the cost of 3x Cuisinart Ice cream makers. KS4 are not able to make ice cream for their 3-hour NEA exam because it takes too long without the use of an ice cream maker. This will allow pupils to add complexity to their dishes and provide more options. It can also be used with KS3 cooking clubs as one of their weekly recipes. These could also be used for other events such as activities week, MasterChef competitions ect.

Right: Achievement Awards - £4500 was donated by the PTA to fund outstanding achievement awards which are given to students at the annual prize-giving event.



Left: <u>SATRO - Competition entry fee and transport costs</u>

Teams of 6 students from Key Stage groups 3, 4 and 5 compete at one of five heats to qualify for the final. The teams are set a problem to solve, using only the materials available, within a fixed time. The qualifying teams are the winners from each Key Stage from each heat plus the next best five teams overall.



Below: £3200 has been pledged for 10 x Lego Spike Primes for Robotics kits used in extra-curricular provision. Offers yr7 and 8 a chance to learn and develop their understanding of robotics using a rolling termly delivery plan. Enables years 9 and 10 to compete in First Lego League competitions.
