Nonsuch High School PTA is a member of PTA-UK, a nationwide organisation for providing advice and services to school Parent/Teacher associations. All trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration or other benefits.

Objectives and Activities

Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

To advance the education of the pupils in the School and in furtherance of this object the Association may:

- Develop more extended relationships between staff, parents/guardians and others associated with the School;
- Engage in activities that support the School and advance the education of pupils attending it;
- Provide and assist in the provision of facilities for education at the School (not normally provided by the Department of Education).

Summary of the main activities undertaken for public benefit in relation to these objects

- Raising funds to supplement and support the school's educational activities, through such events as fairs and refreshments, sales of preloved school uniforms and the 200 Club monthly draw.
- Providing logistical support for school activities and events and generally providing a link between the students' parents/carers and the teaching/governing body.

Achievements and Performance for the year

The Nonsuch High School PTA normally runs a series of events throughout the year to engage and support parents and raise funds for the school. While we slowly moved away from a most challenging funding year faced in 2020/21, we continued to be restricted and thus maintained online PTA meetings primarily. However, this did not prevent us from arranging a number of new and of course well established fundraising events. They all were met with positive feedback as well as generating net funds into the PTA coffers resulting in another successful financial year.

For the financial year 2021/22, the PTA ended the year with a net surplus of over £12,700 on its Income and Expenditure account. This was up from the £7,700 surplus made the previous year. In addition, cash balances in the PTA accounts were also increased from the previous year – a reflection of successful fundraising activities as well as managing expenditure prudently. Only some of our activities and funding for the academic year 2020/2021 are highlighted below to just give a flavour:

200 Club Draws

The '200 Club' draw is a cornerstone activity in raising funds and this year, despite continued challenging circumstances, we raised a net amount in excess of £4300.

Preloved Uniform Sale

The PTA Committee organised a Preloved Uniform Sale, particularly over the summer at the school, generating net sales of nearly £2700.

Quiz Night

A very successful quiz night was put on in the school hall which generated funds close to £900. This was despite the questions being a lot harder than expected!

Doughnut Sale

Always a firm favourite – especially with the students – this helped raise nearly £1000.

Balloon Race

This new and online race activity generated a fair amount of interest (and competitive streak in some!) leading to income generated of over £700.

Murder Mystery Event

This was another new event put on for the first time which attracted much interest as well as close to £1000.

Miscellaneous income including Amazon Smile

This year the PTA has raised in excess of £500 through the shopping channels including the Amazon Smile programme, and we thank the parents for signing up for it.

Contributions to the School

This year the PTA was once again able to fund all of the school funding requests, of close to £5,000, that contributed towards supporting learning and for the well-being of the students. This included:


