

Update from the Chair

Dear Parents and Carers.

A very happy new year to you and your families from the PTA. I hope you had a great holiday period and had some time to rest and reflect on the year just gone.

Since my last update, the PTA machine has kept moving behind the scenes. Several initiatives are in progress. Our next event is the Bag2School which we hope will provide an opportunity for the Nonsuch community to donate unwanted clothes in bags which will benefit the PTA - Just drop your bags off at Nonsuch School Park gate in Nonsuch Park on either the 18th Jan or 19th Jan between 8 am and 8.30 am. The bags will be weighed and the PTA will be paid (50p per kg)!

The Christmas Raffle was an outstanding success. With your help and generosity, we managed to raise £2400 profit! Along with the other events, we have had a great start to the year. The 200 Club is a big focus for us in terms of fundraising as it's our biggest revenue earner so we are trying to grow our subscriber numbers - so please join up if you haven't already. And the more subscribers we have - the bigger the prize pot!

This term we have the **Krispy Kreme Doughnut Pop-up Shop!** As you can imagine, this is a very popular event where we sell 1,000 doughnuts in 30 minutes!

We were very satisfied with the feedback from the walking challenge so we are looking to do a variation on this type of community event in the future, possibly a cycling event in the summer term - so watch this space.

Finally, I would also like to encourage anyone who donated to either the Walking Challenge or Hiruki's London to Paris Bike ride to check if their employer has a Matched Funding scheme. More details on Matched Funding are on the next page. I am pleased to report we have received £730 of matched funding so far from companies.

Matched Funding Scheme -

Did you know that many companies offer their employees Matched Fund Schemes, whereby employers match money raised by a given charity.

For an introduction to what Matched Funding is, please have a look at the national PTA website.

As Nonsuch PTA is a registered charity, these schemes are an excellent way of raising additional money for our school. Our Walking Challenge and Hiruki's Paris Bike ride is an ideal time to ask your HR department if they offer Matched Funding and a little bit of your time could raise double the funds for our school. So far we have been able to raise £730 through matched funding!

If you work for an organisation that has a Matched Funding Policy, any money you raise could be matched by your employer. Companies may match the fundraising total for an event, or for the stall that their employee is working on. Usually, the employee will need to supply them with a letter from the organisation detailing the date and nature of the event, together with the total raised. We understand that the high street banks, building societies, supermarkets and large corporations are likely to do match funding, but these schemes are not exclusive to the major corporate giants. If you work for an independent company, they may be interested in Matched Funding too, as well as other schemes such as Charitable Giving.

We would be grateful if you could see if your employer has a Matched Funding Scheme, or if they are willing to match fund any of our events. If you can't help out this time, but you know the company you work for has a Matched Funding Policy, please let us know by emailing pta@nonsuchschool.org Matched Funding could be a really large source of income for us and help us raise money to support and enrich our students experience.
