How we assess your daughter's progress

- There will be regular vocabulary and grammar tests, as well as end-of-unit assessments, which will test your daughter in all four skill areas (speaking, listening, reading and writing)
- Homework will be given after every lesson (20 minutes) and may be learning for a vocabulary test, or revising for an end-of-unit test, or may be a reading exercise or preparation for a speaking activity
- All creative writing and assessments will be marked and graded, and your daughter will be given clear guidance on what she has done well and what she needs to do in order to improve.
- Progress of the class will also be assessed during lessons and your daughter's teacher will adapt the lesson according to the needs of the class.
