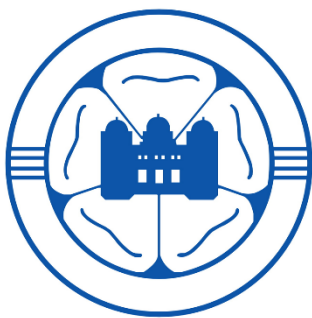

## WHAT IS OUR SCHOOL FUND?

At Nonsuch, we are extremely proud of the academic achievements of our students, but we also want their experience of school to extend far beyond examination outcomes. Providing opportunities for students to develop their confidence, independence, interests and sense of belonging is an important part of the education we provide. Our School Fund enables us to do things that would simply not be possible through our core funding alone. It allows us to invest in our students' environment, extend the range of enrichment opportunities available to them and support projects that make a real difference to their day-to-day experience of school. This year, our priorities include continuing to develop our Sixth Form environment as it grows, improving our student-facing reception and support spaces, and maintaining the breadth of enrichment and opportunities available to students across the school.

We recognise that any contribution to the School Fund is entirely voluntary and that circumstances are different for every family. We are enormously grateful for every donation, whether regular or one-off. Collectively, these contributions enable us to continue investing in opportunities and facilities that benefit our students now and in the future.

Over recent years, support from parents, carers and alumnae has enabled us to invest in a wide range of opportunities and improvements across the school. Looking ahead, our priorities for 2026/27 are set out below.

### FUNDING FUTURE PRIORITIES

This year we are seeking support across three key areas:

#### **Student Experience, Inclusion and Belonging**

We are committed to creating an environment where every student feels supported, valued and able to thrive. A key priority is the development of a new Student Reception and Student Services area, creating a welcoming, accessible and purposeful hub where students can seek help, access support and deal with the practical aspects of school life. More broadly, we are committed to creating an environment where every student feels supported, valued and able to thrive.

#### **Sixth Form Development**

As our Sixth Form continues to grow, we want to create an environment that reflects the quality and ambition of our academic provision. This includes developing spaces that support independent study, collaboration, enrichment activities and student wellbeing, whilst strengthening the identity of our Sixth Form community.

#### **Enrichment and Opportunity**

We want every student to benefit from opportunities beyond the classroom. Donations help us provide visiting speakers, specialist coaches, competitions, enrichment activities and experiences that broaden horizons, build confidence and support personal development.

## HOW MUCH TO DONATE

How much you choose to donate is entirely voluntary and a personal decision.

There is no expectation on families to contribute and every donation, regardless of size, is greatly appreciated.

Many families choose to support the School Fund through a regular monthly contribution. As an indication:

- £10 per month helps support enrichment activities and student opportunities.
- £25 per month helps contribute towards improvements to student facilities and learning environments.
- £50 per month helps support significant investments in school projects and student experience.

Every donation, regardless of size, makes a meaningful difference to our students.

## HOW TO DONATE

Donating money to the School Fund couldn't be easier. There are three different ways depending on your preference.

### 1. QUICK DONATION USING PAYDIT

Making a one-off donation is now easier than ever.

Simply scan the QR code below using your smartphone camera to make a secure donation through Paydit. You can opt to gift aid your donation through the portal if you are a UK taxpayer.

If you would like to make a regular contribution, standing orders can be set up quickly and securely using the details below.

## 2. STANDING ORDER

For regular donations, simply set up a *standing order* in your online banking app using the same details:

## MAKE YOUR DONATION GO FURTHER WITH GIFT AID

**If you are a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid increases the value of your donation by 25% at no additional cost to you.**

As a member of the Girls' Learning Trust, Nonsuch High School for Girls has the same status as a charity. Gift Aid allows UK charities to claim back the basic rate tax already paid on donations by the donor. This means we can claim back from the government on your behalf 25p for every £1 donated, boosting the value of the donation by a quarter.

To enable us to claim Gift Aid, you need to:

- Be a UK taxpayer (Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax).
- Have paid at least as much in UK tax in that tax year as the amount of Gift Aid we will claim.
- Complete the Gift Aid declaration via PaydIT or on our separate form by clicking on this link: [Gift Aid Declaration](#).

Gift Aid does not cost you anything extra, but it makes your donation go further.
