- We would **strongly advise against** parking in Nonsuch Park. Parking becomes very congested causing significant delays.

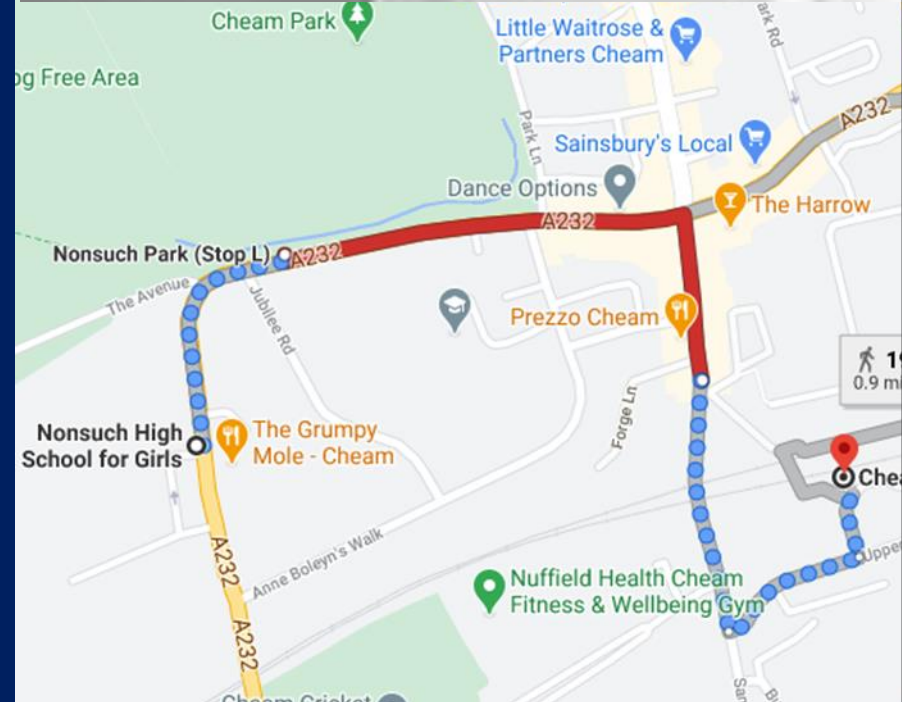


Plan your journey

Cheam Train Station is approximately 19 minutes walk from the school grounds

What will my child need to bring?

Your child **MUST** bring a print out of the email which shows their candidate number and arrival point

- A clear plastic pencil case or bag
- Two or more HB or B pencils
- A soft, good quality rubber
- A pencil sharpener
- A ruler to help them keep their place on the answer sheet
- A bottle of water (no fizzy drinks) in a clear plastic sports cap bottle and a small snack (**NO NUTS**) for the break. **THE WATER BOTTLE MUST HAVE NO MARKINGS**
- Waterproof jacket (ideally with a hood) and a jumper or fleece
- A pack of tissues
- Optional: A book to read during the break (has nothing to do with the exam and should be a book that your child is reading for pleasure)

Your child should not bring a mobile telephone or any other electronic device, a calculator or calculator watch or smartwatch; any watch that beeps; any piece of stationery that displays times tables or other such information or a dictionary.

Please do not send your child to the exam with a large backpack/bag as space in the exam areas is limited. We recommend using a tote bag or carrier bag.

Front School Entrance Instructions

Via the Ewell Road

Access to the site will be denied before 8.30am.

No earlier than 08:30 and no later than 09:00

- **Marshalls will be present to assist you.**
- The pathway leading to the school site will get very busy. Please ensure you use the pedestrian crossing.
- You must enter the school site by foot and then turn left into our compound car park area to drop off your child. A one way system will be in operation. Please follow signs and instructions.
- **Drop off and collection will be at the same location.**
