Our Open Day Event

Our annual Open Day provides a chance for Year 5 students and their families to view our school and the facilities we offer; to learn more about the outstanding curriculum, pastoral support and extra-curricular/enrichment we provide before deciding where to spend their child's secondary school career.

We aim to ensure this event is a positive and enjoyable experience for all attendees. Any inappropriate behaviour towards any member of our school community will not be tolerated, and we reserve the right to refuse entry to any individual whose conduct does not meet these expectations.

Please note that we operate a different booking system to Wallington High School for Girls. To avoid any confusion or disappointment, kindly read the guidance below carefully when booking your tickets.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS)

Attendance guidelines:

1. **My daughter is in Year 4 - can we attend?** This event is designed for current Year 5 students and their families. We would love to welcome you to our Open Day in 2027 instead.
2. **My daughter has a confirmed place in Year 7 for September 2026 - can we attend?** If your child has a confirmed Year 7 place for September 2026, there is no need to attend. You will be invited to a separate induction event.
3. **Are younger siblings allowed to attend?** Younger siblings are not restricted from attending; however, we strongly advise that they do not as the school site becomes very busy and congested. If they do attend they must have a valid ticket.
4. **Are pushchairs allow on site?** No. Due to the high level of footfall during the event, pushchairs are not permitted on site for health and safety reasons.

Tickets and registration:

1. **Do I need to book a ticket to attend the Open Day?** Yes. Families must book **one ticket for each individual attending**. This can only be done via the link on the school website. Visitors without a valid ticket will not be permitted entry.
2. **Do children need their own tickets?** Yes. Every attendee, including children and adults, must have a ticket.
3. **Is there a limit on the number of tickets per family?** Yes. Due to high demand, each family can book a maximum of three tickets. This includes your Year 5 child.
4. **Can I book more than one timeslot?** No. Only 1 timeslot can be booked per family and tickets are only valid for that entry time.
5. **Will I receive a confirmation email after booking?** Yes. You will first receive an automatic confirmation email from the booking system; however, this is not your ticket. A separate email will be sent during the week commencing 29 June confirming your ticket allocation, entry details, and key information. This email will serve as your official ticket and must be presented on arrival.
6. **What should I do if I do not receive an automatic confirmation email?** Please check your inbox carefully, including your spam or junk folders. If you are still unable to locate the confirmation email, it may indicate that your booking was not successfully completed. In this case, please contact us at rsvp@nonsuchschool.org and we will confirm whether your booking has been received. If you have already received the confirmation email, no further action is required.

7. **What should I do if I don't receive my confirmation email from the school the week commencing 29 June?** Please check your inbox carefully, including your spam or junk folder. If you still cannot find it, please email rsvp@nonsuchschool.org.
8. **Can I change my booking if needed?** No. To help us manage the event efficiently, bookings cannot be amended once the registration process has been completed. Please ensure all details are correct before submitting your booking.
9. **Can I cancel my booking?** Yes. If you wish to cancel your booking please email rsvp@nonsuchschool.org. Please note that we cannot guarantee that tickets will still be available if you then choose to rebook.
10. **What should I do if the event is fully booked?** If all tickets have been allocated, an "Add me to the waitlist" option will be available within the booking system. By selecting this option, you will be added to the waiting list and contacted should any tickets subsequently become available.

Attending the Open Day

1. **What time should I arrive for the Open Day?** Visitor arrival times are staggered over 5 different timeslots to help reduce congestion. You must arrive at the time specified on your ticket, which will be clearly stated in your booking confirmation.
2. **What happens if I arrive late for my timeslot?** If you miss your allocated timeslot, you will not be permitted entry for health and safety reasons.
3. **Can I attend multiple timeslots?** No. You will only be permitted entry for the timeslot of your booked tickets.
4. **Where do I check in when I arrive?** To help reduce congestion in the local area, different entry points are allocated for each timeslot. Please ensure you check your ticket carefully, as it will indicate your designated entry point. Entry will only be permitted via the correct location.
5. **Do I need to bring my ticket or confirmation email?** Yes. You must bring your email with your ticket details that you will receive the week beginning 29 June. Entry is not permitted without it and will be checked by a member of staff upon arrival.
6. **How long does the Open Day last?** We suggest you allow for a minimum of 1 hour and a maximum of 2 hours and 35 minutes for your visit.
7. **Is there parking available on site?** No. Onsite parking is unavailable unless the visitor is a Blue Badge holder. Limited parking is available in Cheam so we would strongly advise using public transport. We are proud to be part of our local community and ask visitors to support this by parking thoughtfully during the open day. Please respect residents by not blocking driveways or causing obstruction, and by following local parking rules.
8. **What accessibility arrangements are in place for visitors?** If you are a Blue Badge holder, require wheelchair access, or have a hearing impairment, please contact us in advance of the event at office@nonsuchschool.org so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
